# DATA SOURCE

## COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH (CAD) RECORDS INFORMATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (RIMS)

Using a computerized systems lets us automatically:

- Document calls for service (Police/Fire/Operations)
- Implement Crime Analysis
- Send information out to Officers using Mobile CAD
- Map locations
- Track Evidence and Property





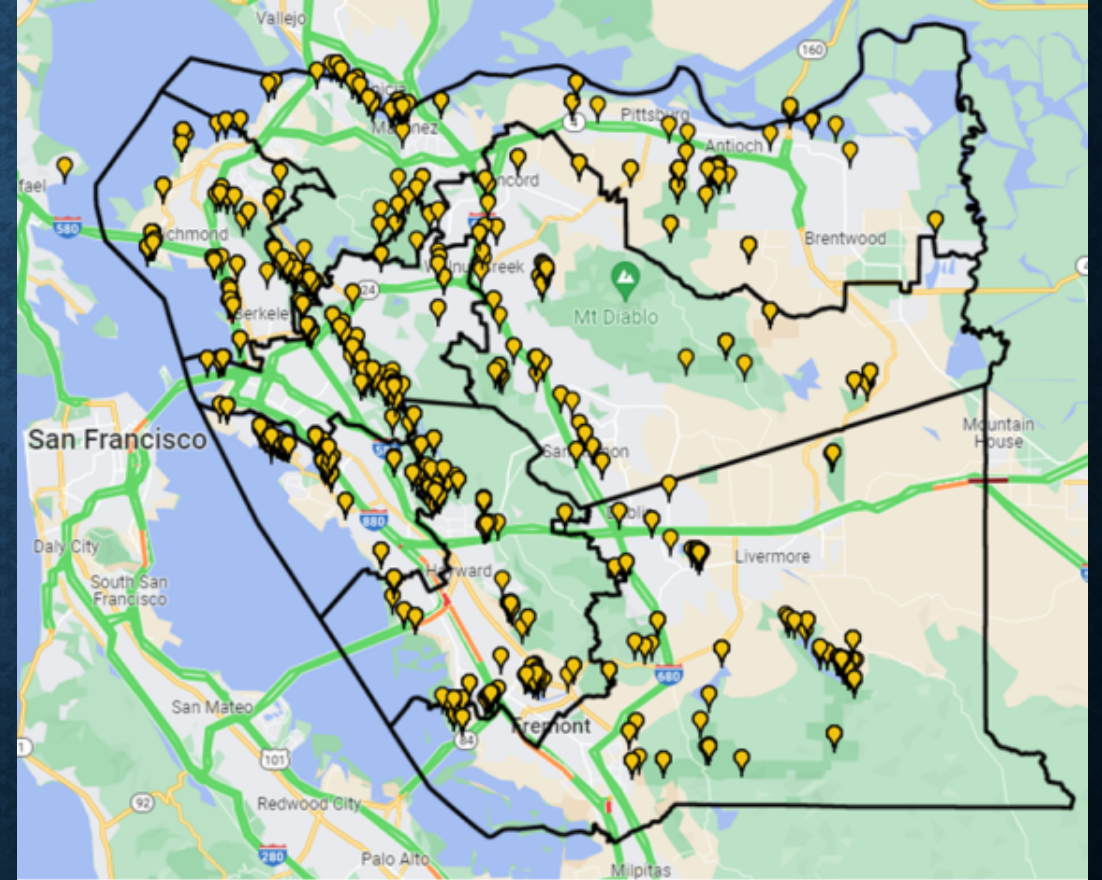
# Q2 -- April – June 2024

## EAST BAY REG. PARK DISTRICT POLICE DEPT

### Incidents – Q2 2024

An Incident is any event that requires the dispatch of a Police or Fire unit.

- May also be an officer-initiated provision of service.
- Sometimes generated to record events for informational purposes





# Incidents – Q2 2024

## 6,161 Dispatched Incidents

- Incidents rise 36% on weekend days as compared to weekdays.
- The majority (47%) of incidents occurred between 12:00 PM and 8:00 PM.
- 28% of incidents occurred between 10:00 PM and 5:00 AM.





# Incidents – Q2 2024

## 6,161 Dispatched Incidents

- Calls for Service : 4,381
- Officer Initiated Incidents: 2,680
- 217 - Traffic Stops
- 1,031 - Vehicle & pedestrian stops
- 637 - Security checks and special patrols





# Citations – Q2 2024

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**TOTAL: 1,291 citations**

A Citation is an official notice to appear at court related to a criminal charge or infraction violation usually issued by Law Enforcement or Code Enforcement Officer

- Misdemeanor - **31**
- Ordinance Citations - **209**
- Other Infractions – **111**
- Parking - **940**





# Arrests – Q2 2024

Definition: An arrest is a seizure of a person by legal restraint in response to a criminal charge.

There are several types of arrests:

- In-field cite and release – typically for misdemeanor charges
- Custodial Arrest without a warrant – Custodial restraint plus transport pursuant to misdemeanor or felony charges.
- Custodial Arrest pursuant to an outstanding warrant – Judge or Magistrate has ordered the arrest of person pursuant to charges in a criminal case.





# Arrests – Q2 2024

TOTAL: **119**

- Misdemeanor Arrests – **75**
- Felony Arrests - **44**
- Custodial Arrest pursuant to an outstanding warrant – **32**





# Cases – Q2 2024

A Case is a report written by an Officer or Public Safety Technician to document an event.

- Documentation of a crime used by the DA to prosecute a suspect.
- Also used to report criminal data to the Department of Justice or FBI for statistical purposes.

**519 Cases**

- 129 - Felony Cases
- 114 - Misdemeanors Cases
- 28 - Accident reports

# Significant Cases

## Q2 2024

Cases generally increase as the Department transitions into Summer. Here are some statistical highlights from Q2:

- 10 firearms taken off the street
- 8 arrests for possession of a stolen vehicle
- 8 arrests for driving under the influence
- 7 arrests for fleeing from the police in motor vehicles
- 6 arrests for sex crimes or failing to register as a sex offender
- 6 arrests for burglary
- 4 arrests for possessing dangerous weapons (other than firearms)





# Significant Cases

## Q2 2024

Here are some case highlights from Q2:

- Commercial burglary suspect arrested while breaking into a park office.
- Probationer arrested for contacting a minor with intent to have sex.
- Repeat DUI offender arrested.
- Detective follow-up resulted in identification of an auto burglary suspect, a kidnapping suspect, and the arrest of a robbery suspect.

The East Bay Regional Park District has launched a **new system** to make information about police and fire activity more accessible to the public. The system also includes an interactive webpage with near real-time **mapping of police and fire activity**, including location, date and time, a general description, and outcome. The new system also allows the public to sign up for daily or weekly email updates with a summary of public safety activity and links to more information.

The new system is provided by Sun Ridge Systems, Inc. – Citizen RIMS and housed on Crimegraphics.com, which integrates with the Park District's existing Public Safety Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS). The new system allows updates to be emailed out automatically rather than manually by public safety staff, increasing efficiency and allowing staff to focus on other important activities.

Most importantly, the new system increases public transparency by making disclosable public safety activity information more accessible. The system allows any member of the public to access near real-time public safety activity mapping information and sign up for daily or weekly email updates.

Access to daily or weekly updates is available via an easy one-time sign-up process. Email addresses are entered into Citizen RIMS / crimegraphics.com and will only be used to send email update to subscribers.
