**RECOMMENDATION**

This is an informational item only. Public Safety will make a special presentation recognizing National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week: April 13th-19th, 2025.

**BACKGROUND**

National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week (NPSTW) is observed annually during the second full week of April to honor the dedicated professionals who serve as public safety telecommunicators. In 2025, NPSTW will take place from April 13 to April 19. This week serves as an opportunity to recognize the critical role these individuals play in ensuring public safety and supporting first responders.

The origins of NPSTW date back to 1981 when Patricia Anderson of the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office in California initiated the observance. It gained national recognition in 1994 when President Bill Clinton signed Presidential Proclamation 6667, officially designating the second week of April as NPSTW.

The East Bay Regional Park District would like to acknowledge NPSTW and express deep appreciation for the critical role that the EBRPD Public Safety Dispatchers play in protecting communities across Alameda and Contra Costa counties.
