RECOMMENDATION

This is an informational item.

BACKGROUND

The North Basin Strip is a management area of the McLaughlin Eastshore State Park, located in Berkeley, CA. It is situated south of the Tom Bates Regional Sports Fields (at Gilman Street) and north of the Berkeley Meadow (at University Avenue). The M. Eastshore State Park is the 2nd most visited park in the entire Park District with approximately 500,000 annual visitors.

Previously, this project was presented on March 5, 2024 (Full Board) to authorize a consultant contract to conduct technical studies, public outreach, and preliminary design for sea level rise adaptation, habitat improvements, and public access facilities. On November 6, 2024 (Board Executive Committee) an informational item presentation covered project opportunities and constraints.

Upcoming outreach activities include community meetings scheduled for mid to late May 2025 to review and obtain feedback on alternative conceptual plans.

Scott Stoller, Civil Engineer in Design and Construction, will present on project progress to date, including a summary of the first round of public outreach and alternative conceptual plans.

FISCAL IMPACT

The project will require additional funds to complete CEQA, design and construction, if authorized by the Board.
