**RECOMMENDATION**

The General Manager recommends the Board of Directors approve the below appointments to the Park Advisory Committee for a term commencing upon adoption of this resolution and ending on December 31, 2026:

1. Carlyn Obringer, appointment of Contra Costa County Mayors' Conference; and
2. Roland Williams, appointment of Alameda County California Special Districts Association.

**BACKGROUND**

Per the East Bay Regional Park District (Park District) Board Operating Guidelines, Appendix C, the twenty-one-member Park Advisory Committee (PAC) is established by and for the Board of Directors to provide community perspectives and advice to staff and to the Board on the issues, projects and policies of the Park District. PAC members typically serve a two-year term ending December 31. Board approval would authorize the following to serve on the Park Advisory Committee for the remainder of a two-year term commencing upon adoption of this resolution until December 31, 2026:

Appointee Carlyn Obringer is to serve their fourth two-year term. Carlyn Obringer was first elected to the Concord City Council in November 2016, and was re-elected in 2020. She served as Vice Mayor in 2018 and mayor in 2019. Obringer previously served on the City's Design Review Board and the Planning Commission, which she chaired. A regional leader, Obringer served as chair of the East Bay Regional Park District Parks Advisory Committee, from 2021-2023. She is a founding member of the Diablo Valley Tech Initiative, represents the Contra Costa Mayors Conference on the East Bay Economic Development Alliance, and serves on the Contra Costa Airport Land Use

Committee. Obringer also chaired TRANSPAC (a Central County regional transportation planning body) and represents Concord on the Innovate 680 Policy Advisory Committee. She holds a Master of Business Administration from the Monterey Institute of International Studies. Obringer's favorite East Bay Regional Park is the Temescal Regional Recreation Area as she and her husband, Justin, were married at the Temescal Beach House.

Appointee Roland Williams is to serve their fourth two-year term. Castro Valley resident, Roland Williams, is the General Manager of the Castro Valley Sanitary District (CVSan), where he has received several awards and acknowledgements for professional organizational excellence and leadership. Most recently, he received the Eden Area Regional Occupational Program Business Partner of the Year award for inspiring students to become successful and positive citizens.

In addition to serving on the Park Advisory Committee, he has served on the California Association of Sanitation Agencies (CASA) Utility Leadership Committee, sits on the CASA Board of Directors, serves on the California Sanitation Risk Management Authority (CSRMA) Workers Compensation Committee and sits on the CSRMA Board of Directors, is President of the Alameda County Special District's Association, is a member of California Water Environment Association (CWEA), Water Environment Federation (WEF), American Public Works Association (APWA), and has held various volunteer roles with these organizations.

Roland is also a member of the Castro Valley Rotary Club and has recently been appointed to the Baywood Court Retirement Community Board. In his spare time, you can find him reading, traveling, golfing, and spending time with family at Lake Chabot, Pleasanton Ridge, Sunol, Las Trampas and Redwood Regional Parks.

Statement from Carlyn Obringer:

The East Bay Regional Park District's system holds particular meaning for me, which is why I am honored to have been reappointed to serve on the Park Advisory Committee by the Contra Costa Mayors' Conference. Since moving to the Bay Area in 2004, I have enjoyed running along the Contra Costa Canal Trail and hiking in the Black Diamond Mines Regional Preserve, Briones Regional Park and Redwood Regional Park. My husband even proposed to me in Tilden Regional Park, and we were married at the Lake Temescal Beach House. I have been honored to serve on a body like the Park Advisory Committee that works to support the preservation of the natural beauty of the land, and provide recreational opportunities and enjoyment in the East Bay. I am also deeply involved in decision-making regarding the complex issues related to the redevelopment of the former Concord Naval Weapons Station, as Vice Mayor of Concord, and know that the most popular aspect of the project among the residents of Concord and surrounding communities is the establishment and opening of the Thurgood Marshall Regional Park – Home of the Port Chicago 50.
