RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

The East Bay Regional Park District (Park District) regularly hosts events to cultivate strategic relationships with elected officials and agency partners. Event types include site visits, walk and talks, advocacy conferences and relationship building meetings. Staff representatives from the General Manager's Office in Government and Legislative Affairs will provide an informational update to the Board Legislative Committee (Committee) on site visits and meetings which occurred since the last meeting of this Committee on January 10, 2024.

ANALYSIS

Site Visits and Events recently hosted by the East Bay Regional Park District include:

- 1. California Coastal Conservancy Staff Site Visit, Tidewater Boating Center, MLK Jr. Regional Shoreline, January 12**
Park District staff including representation from Government and Legislative Affairs, Grants, Park Operations, and Design and Construction met with three staff members from the California Coastal Conservancy, including their Executive Director, to discuss the future development of Tidewater Day Use Area Public Access Project.
- 2. California Coastal Conservancy & Parks California Site Visit, McLaughlin Eastshore State Park, March 1**
Park District staff including representation from Government and Legislative Affairs, Grants, Park Operations, and Design and Construction met with the Executive Director of the California Coastal Conservancy and Parks California's President and CEO, to discuss future development of Brickyard Cove, Berkeley Meadow and the North Basin Strip.
- 3. Civicorps Pittsburgh Satellite facility, March 7**
Director Coffey and Park District staff including representation from Government and Legislative Affairs and Park Operations, met with staff members from Civicorps to tour their Pittsburgh facility and discuss potential partnership at a Park District site near Bollinger Canyon.
