**RECOMMENDATION**

This is an informational item.

**BACKGROUND**

The 2023 Park District Adopted Budget included the addition of a Unit Manager position to the Park Operations Department. The current organizational structure of the Department is comprised of six Unit Managers, overseeing six areas that are based on the function and activity of each unit. With the addition of a new Unit Manager position, the Park Operations Department will undergo a reorganization that will change the current structure from functional area units to geographical-based units. The following re-organization will result in the units becoming consolidated geographically, some units will have a reduction in overall acreage and the addition of an additional unit for a total of seven-unit areas. This presentation will provide an overview and summary of the implementation of the re-organization process, reporting structures and update on the new Unit Manager recruitment. Except for the new unit manager position, no assigned work or work locations will change as an outcome of the reorganization.
