RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

During the 2017 and 2023 winters, the East Bay Regional Park District's (Park District) lands and facilities incurred damage from large storms and above average rainfall. Damage included landslides, road/culvert failures, bridge/dock/pier failures, flood damage and debris accumulation. To address this damage, the Park District has utilized several means and methods. Projects to remedy the damage were identified as either a Trails, Creeks, and Ponds (TCP) project, meaning there was a portion of the project which lands within jurisdictional areas and require environmental regulatory approvals via the District's Regional General Permit; non-regulatory projects that staff could work on or manage contractors to work on such as debris removal and storm cleanup; and those projects that were deemed FEMA projects, due to the cost and scope of the damage and necessary repair. Ren Bates, Chief of Design & Construction will provide an update on the 2017 FEMA project list as well as the status of the 2023 FEMA process. This is an informational item.
