



5-Year Hazard Report History





WE DON'T GIVE UP!



We made significant progress on a Cold Case, narrowing down a suspect list to 6 people. We are dedicated to solving crime and bringing justice to victims and survivors.

SEXUAL PREDATOR ARRESTED



One of our officers saw suspicious activity occurring inside of a parked vehicle within the lot. Further investigation revealed two occupants, a 21-year-old male and a 12-year-old female, engaging in sexual activity. The male was arrested and charged with multiple felony sex crimes.

HOMICIDE SOLVED IN 9 DAYS



A male victim was shot and killed while sitting in his vehicle at the MLK JR. Regional Shoreline boat launch. Witnesses gave a specific description of the suspect vehicle. With the use of Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) cameras, the vehicle was located and a suspect was identified. With the assistance of the U.S. Marshal's Service, the suspect was taken into custody 9 days later and charged with his murder.

BURGLARY SOLVED JUSTICE SERVED



A Park District residence was burglarized and tens of thousands of dollars' worth of family heirloom jewelry was stolen. A camera placed at the resident's entrance gate captured images of the suspect and vehicle. Using social media, Detectives followed the sales path of the vehicle and identified a suspect. With the assistance of the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office, the suspect was taken into custody the following day, leading to a 4-year prison sentence and 80% of the victim's jewelry, as well as stolen property from other agencies, being recovered and returned.





East Bay Regional Park District Public Safety Student Aide (PSSA) Program began as a pilot program in 2016. It has proven to be a huge success! In addition, we have 4 employees who began part-time or were seasonal staff, who are now full-time employees!
