BACKGROUND

Staff provides a regular update to the Board Legislative Committee of the East Bay Regional Park District's (Park District) Strategic Actions of Governmental Entities (SAGE) Program, which is managed by the Acquisition, Stewardship and Development Division. The following specific items outlined in the table below will be presented.

ANALYSIS

A monthly report of specific actions by local governmental agencies is issued to spotlight actions that have a direct nexus with the Park District's mission delivery. For this reporting period, there were three actions mapped to facilitate awareness and understanding of these matters in terms of potential impacts to the Park District as noted in the table below.

Jurisdiction	Body	Date	Description
Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA)		End of 2023	Dynamic Personal Micro Transit (DPMT) Project. A multi-city, on-demand transit option designed to meet the diverse mobility needs of people in Eastern Contra Costa County (ECCC). In 2021, the cities of Antioch, Brentwood, Oakley and Pittsburg completed the East County DPMT Feasibility Study to support a potential micro-transit deployment with autonomous vehicles in ECCC. Updated costs and ridership analysis is expected in 2024. Environmental clearance and design are still TBD.

Martinez City Council Dec 20

Staff presented the **Alhambra Hills Public Access and Habitat Management Analysis** and received direction from Council on next steps to prioritize for the management of the Alhambra Hills Preserve. Briones Regional Park is adjacent to the Preserve's southwestern boundary, and a proposed segment of the Martinez-Briones Regional Trail extends through the Preserve.

CA State Parks Nov 14

A Visioning Workshop for the **Alameda-Tesla Plan** was held at the Livermore Public Library. The project seeks to develop a comprehensive plan that will incorporate the Alameda-Tesla's 3,100-acre property in the Bay Area as a new park unit within the CA State Parks system.
