DATA SOURCE

COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH (CAD) RECORDS INFORMATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (RIMS)

Using a computerized systems lets us automatically:

- Document calls for service (Police/Fire/Operations)
- Implement Crime Analysis
- Send information out to Officers using Mobile CAD
- Map locations
- Track Evidence and Property



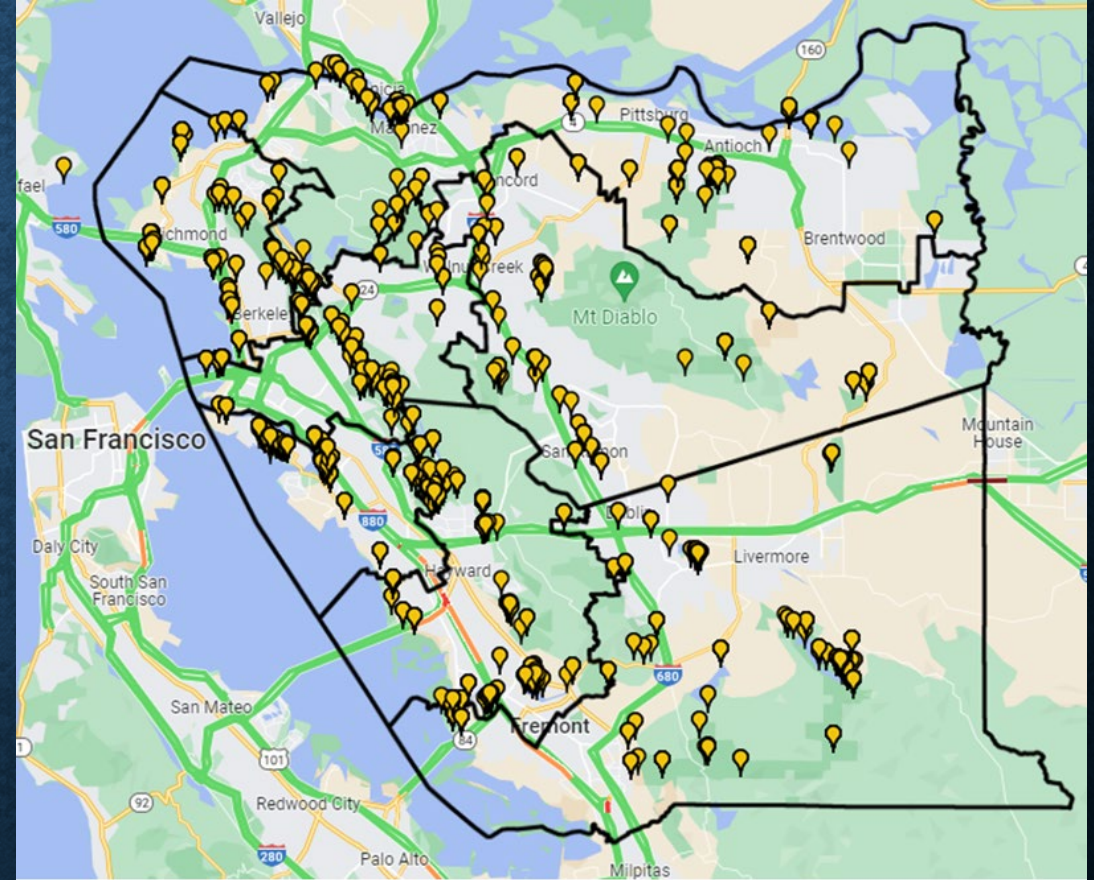

Incidents – Q4 2024

An Incident is any event that requires the dispatch of a Police or Fire unit.

- may also be an officer-initiated provision of service.
- sometimes generated to record events for informational purposes



Incidents – Q4 2024

3,551 Dispatched Incidents

- Incidents on weekends account for 31% of total incidents.
- The majority (47%) of incidents occurred between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM.
- 23% of incidents occurred between 10:00 PM and 5:00 AM.



Incidents – Q4 2024

3,551 Dispatched Incidents

- Calls for Service : 1,705
- Officer Initiated Incidents: 1,846
 - 187 - Traffic Stops
 - 607 - vehicle & pedestrian stops
 - 625 - security checks and special patrols



Citations – Q4 2024

TOTAL: 316 citations

A Citation is an official notice to appear at court related to a criminal charge or infraction violation usually issued by Law Enforcement or Code Enforcement Officer

- Misdemeanor - 12
- Ordinance Citations - 58
- Other Infractions – 75
- Parking - 171



Arrests – Q4 2024

Definition: An arrest is a seizure of a person by legal restraint in response to a criminal charge.

There are several types of arrests:

- In-field cite and release – typically for misdemeanor charges
- Custodial Arrest without a warrant – Custodial restraint plus transport pursuant to misdemeanor or felony charges.
- Arrest pursuant to an outstanding warrant – Judge or Magistrate has ordered the arrest of a person pursuant to charges in a criminal case.



Arrests – Q4 2024

TOTAL: 57

- Misdemeanor Arrests – 37
- Felony Arrests - 20
- Arrest pursuant to an outstanding warrant – 22



Cases – Q4 2024

A Case is a report written by an Officer or Public Safety Technician to document an event.

- Documentation of a crime used by the DA to prosecute a suspect.
- Also used to report criminal data to the Department of Justice or FBI for statistical purposes.

327 Cases

- 60 - Felony Cases
- 75 - Misdemeanors Cases
- 6 - Accident reports

61% of 327 Cases for Q4 2024 200

- 106 - Cases submitted for prosecution
- 24 - Cases charged
- 51 - Cases declined for prosecution



Significant Cases

Q4 2024

Cases generally decrease during late Fall into Winter.

Here are some statistical highlights from Q4:

- 3 firearms taken off the street
- 3 arrests for possessing dangerous weapons (other than firearms)
- 3 arrests for possession of a stolen vehicle
- 7 arrests for driving under the influence
- 5 arrests for fleeing from the police in motor vehicles
- 4 arrests for sex crimes or failing to register as a sex offender
- 4 arrests for possession of drugs for sale
- 1 arrest for arson



Significant Cases

Q4 2024

Here are some case highlights from Q4:

- Cold case homicide in Tilden from 1990 was solved.
- Two separate probationers were arrested and returned to jail for committing new crimes.
- Detectives worked with other police departments to identify organized crime suspects responsible for millions of dollars of damage and commercial property loss throughout the SF Bay area. Although not part of Q4, one suspect has since been arrested by EBRPD.

Crime never stops and neither do we.

The East Bay Regional Park District has launched a **new system** to make information about police and fire activity more accessible to the public. The system also includes an interactive webpage with near real-time **mapping of police and fire activity**, including location, date and time, a general description, and outcome. The new system also allows the public to sign up for daily or weekly email updates with a summary of public safety activity and links to more information.

The new system is provided by Sun Ridge Systems, Inc. – Citizen RIMS and housed on Crimegraphics.com, which integrates with the Park District's existing Public Safety Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS). The new system allows updates to be emailed out automatically rather than manually by public safety staff, increasing efficiency and allowing staff to focus on other important activities.

Most importantly, the new system increases public transparency by making disclosable public safety activity information more accessible. The system allows any member of the public to access near real-time public safety activity mapping information and sign up for daily or weekly email updates.

Access to daily or weekly updates is available via an easy one-time sign-up process. Email addresses are entered into Citizen RIMS / crimegraphics.com and will only be used to send email update to subscribers.
