**BACKGROUND**

Fisheries Program Manager Joe Sullivan will present on the Park District’s Reservoir Management Program. The Park District manages seven (7) reservoirs in the east bay for recreational purposes. Five of these reservoirs are operated to provide swimming for the public. District staff has developed a robust monitoring program to ensure swim beaches remain open for as many days possible during the summer swim season. Mr. Sullivan will discuss how the Park District monitors water quality in these reservoirs, what active management District staff are doing to maintain water quality and share some challenges in keeping reservoirs open for recreation. He will introduce, Anja Brey, Acting Ecological Services Coordinator and discuss her coordination work in the Reservoir Management Program.
